



## 2020 Fruit Trees Offered at Squak Mountain Nursery

**Apples:** For pollination, you must have two different varieties of apples in the vicinity. (Sterile varieties cannot pollinate any other varieties.)

Akane	⊗ Red. Firm, juicy with great sweet/tart flavor
Chehalis	Yellow-green. Mild sweet flavor, crisp, juicy.
Cosmic Crisp	⊗ Red. Delicious, crisp, sweet, does not brown when cut open
Enterprise	⊗ Dark Red. Excellent fruit quality.
Fuji	Sweet-tart flavor, yellowish apple with orange-red blush stripes
Gala	Sweet, excellent flavor.
Gravenstein	Yellow blushed red. Sweet/tart flavor. Excellent for cooking. Sterile.
Honeycrisp	⊗ Red. Crisp, juicy, sweet.
Jonagold	Red stripes over yellow. Good for desserts and canning. Sterile.
Liberty	⊗ Red. Crisp, rich sprightly flavor. Juicy.
Lodi	Yellow. Crisp, juicy. Cooking apple.
Pristine	⊗ Green/yellow. Sweet/tart. Crisp. Excellent for apple sauce or fresh eating.
Spartan	⊗ Red. McIntosh type. Crisp, sweet, juicy.
Sunrise Magic	Red, crisp, juicy, sweet.
William's Pride	⊗ Bright Red. Heavy producer. Sweet, rich, spicy flavor.

**Columnar Apples:** Upright, very narrow. 8'-12' tall. Good for smaller yards and container gardening.

Golden Sentinel	Yellow. Sweet, delicious, juicy.
North Pole	Red. Crisp, juicy, sweet. Good for cider, baking, and eating.
Scarlet Sentinel	Green/yellow, red blush. Juicy and sweet.

**4 Way Apples:** 4 different varieties on a tree.

4 way – Spartan, Liberty, Chehalis, Akane, Honeycrisp

4 way – Gala, Honeycrisp, Red McIntosh, Fuji, Braeburn

**Espaliered Apples 2 or 3 tiers:**

3 Tier 1: Honeycrisp, Fuji, Gala

3 Tier 2: Akane, Honeycrisp, Liberty

2 Tier: Honeycrisp, Fuji

**Cherries:** If not self-fertile, you will need two different varieties of cherries for pollination or a combo tree.

Early Burlat	Large, firm red meaty fruit. June.
Lapin	Dark red. Sweet, firm. Crack resistant. Self-fertile.
Montmorency	Red. Sour cooking cherry. Heavy producer. Self-fertile.
Rainier	Yellow with red blush. Sweet and flavorful.
Stella	Black/Red. Rich, sweet flavor. Self-fertile.

**4 Way Cherry:** Bing, Rainier, Glacier, Stella, Van

**Pears:** For pollination plant two different varieties of pears in the same vicinity. Asian and European pears pollinate other pears from the same region best.

### European Pears

Bartlett	Yellow. Thin skin. Heavy producer. Juicy, spicy taste.
Bosc	Brown. Sweet, firm buttery flesh. Great for eating or cooking.
Comice	Green/yellow. Sweet and juicy.
Orcas	Yellow with red blush. Sweet and juicy.
Red Bartlett	Crimson. Sweet. Great for canning or eating.
Rescue	Red/orange. Smooth, buttery, sweet flesh.

**Combo European Pears:** multiple varieties on a tree  
4 way - Possible combinations of Anjou, Bartlett, Flemish Beauty, Red Bartlett, and Rescue

**Espaliered Pear 3 tiers:** Possible combinations of Bartlett, Bosc, and Red Clapps

⊗ more disease resistant, easy to grow

## 2020 Fruit Trees Offered at Squak Mountain Nursery

### Asian Pears

Chojuro	Gold/brown. Crisp. Sweet rich butterscotch flavor.
Nijisseiki	Green-yellow. Crisp, sweet and juicy
Shinseiki	Yellow skinned. Crisp, sweet and juicy. Heavy producer.

**4 Way Asian Pear:** Possible combinations of Anjou, Chojuro, Kosui, Nijisseiki, Shinseiki, and Shinko

**Espaliered Oriental Pear 3 tiers:** Possible combinations of: Chojuro, Nijisseiki, Shinseiki

**Plums and Prunes:** Japanese plums require two different varieties of Japanese plums in the vicinity for pollination to occur.

### European Varieties

Imperial Epineuse	Red/purple. Yellow flesh Firm, sweet, free stone. Self-fertile.
Italian Prune	Purple-black skin. Sweet fruit. Self-fertile.
Seneca	Purple fruit. Great for eating and Canning. Self-fertile.

### Japanese Varieties

Beauty	Red skin, amber flesh. Sweet.
Satsuma	Dark red skin and flesh. Sweet. Solid, meaty flesh.
Shiro	Golden yellow fruit and flesh. Heavy producer.

**4 way Plum:** Possible combinations of Brooks, Seneca, Green Gage, Italian, Stanley, and Yellow Egg

### Apricot

Harglow	Bright orange. Firm, sweet, flavorful. Self-fertile.

### Fig

Desert King	Deep green. Strawberry flesh. Excellent fresh, cooked or dried. Self-fertile.
Olympia	Purple. Violet flesh. Hardy to -10 degrees. Very sweet. Self-fertile.
Violette de Bordeaux	Purple/black. Deep red strawberry flesh. Excellent fresh or dried. Self-fertile.

### Nectarine

Hardy Red	Red skin with golden blush. Yellow flesh, excellent flavor. Self-fertile.

### Olive

Arbequina	Dark brown. Delicious fruit and oil. Hardy to 20 degrees F. Self-fertile.

### Peach

Frost	Delicious yellow freestone. Heavy producer. Excellent for canning or fresh eating. Self-fertile.
Q18	Delicious white freestone. Sweet and juicy. Self-fertile.

### Fruit Salad

Possible combinations of Frost Peach, Green Gage Plum, Italian Plum, Nadia Plum, Harglow Apricot, Hardy Red Nectarine, Puget Gold Apricot

### Persimmon

Fuyu (Jiro)	Orange. Firm, crisp, amazingly sweet. Self-fertile.

### Pomegranate

Eversweet	Red. Very sweet. Clear juice. Virtually seedless. Hummingbird plant! Self-fertile.
